Come and support your tribe and tribal members who will be ascending Lesamo. Although the list is full for climbers. There may be a last minute opening if someone does not show up. I would like to remind tribal members that it

is at my discretion to choose who will go, if I feel that you are not fit to climb I may ask that you not join those who are going. I don't want anyone getting hurt or hurting someone else because they are not in good physical shape. Also if you are a tribal member you should be out supporting this event.

MONITORING UPDATE:

Remember although there has not been much monitoring lately we encourage all monitors to keep educating yourself. Lately there has been some great opportunities for monitors to attend outside training such as archaeological field schools and courses pertaining to environmental laws. There is usually a fee for many of these courses, however so far some tribal members have applied for scholarships and have had their fee waved. Call the office or check the tribal web site for upcoming training opportunities.
