The Tribal TANF Program is similar to CalWorks, but tailored to assist Native American families. We are a program administered by Native Americans to serve Native American families.

North Fork Rancheria Tribal TANF (NFRTT) can serve enrolled members or descendants of a Federally Recognized or Alaskan Tribe and descendants of members of the California Indian Judgment Roll. There must be one or more Native American children under age 18 in the household. We also serve relative caretakers of Native American children.


Services we can provide include monthly cash aid for families whose income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.

We can also assist with supportive services to allow adults in the household to obtain their high school diploma or GED, take college classes or attend a vocational program, prepare for and find employment and other related activities that can help you and your family move toward self-reliance.

We also provide services for youth, which may include educational support and assistance, youth cultural and leadership activities, and assisting in the development and strengthening of healthy lifestyles. We also offer incentives for earning good grades and maintaining good attendance in school, and a bonus for completing your educational goals.
