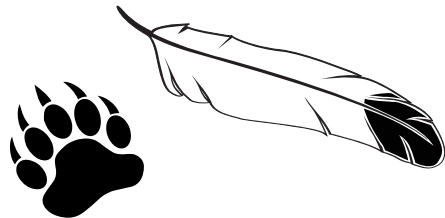

Dear Tribal Members

The Los Padres National Forest would like to make you aware of steps we are taking regarding continued hazardous fire conditions and firearms within the boundaries of Los Padres National Forest. The need of this continued prohibition is based on extreme drought, wildland fuel conditions, limited firefighting resources, and increased visitor use.

The current forest order (05 07 00 21 06) prohibiting the discharge of firearms expires on 1/1/2022. It is our intention to sign another order extending the prohibition through December 2022. This order does not cover the shooting ranges under Special Use Permit, which are the Winchester Canyon Gun Club and the Ojai Valley Gun Club. And it includes an exemption that reads: "Persons hunting a legal game bird or mammal are not exempt from the prohibition listed above. However, a person hunting during the open-hunting season for a game bird or mammal as specified by the laws of the State of California, and having a valid California hunting license in his or her possession, may discharge a firearm at the legal game bird or mammal."
