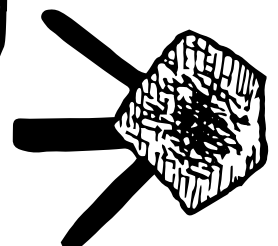
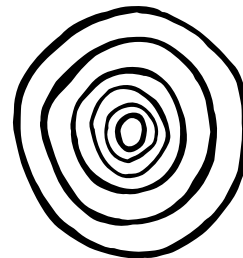
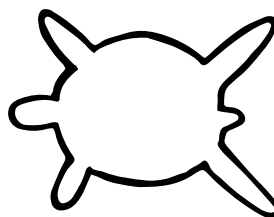
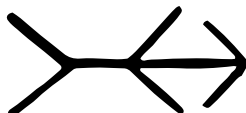
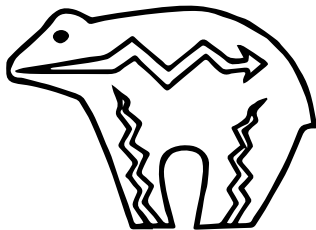
We have a new T-Shirt design and it will be available at the general meeting it will also be on the website soon for viewing. The following sizes are available,

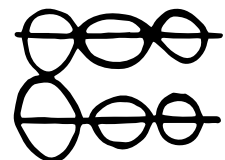
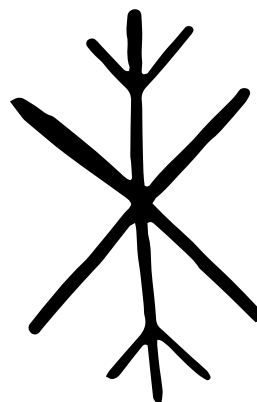
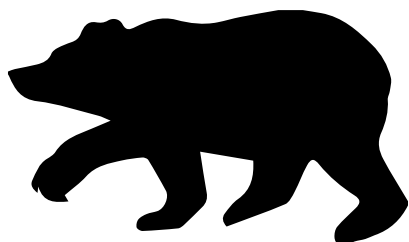
