


San Salvador is a full-scale sixteenth century replica of the flagship used by Spanish explorer Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo will sail into Morro Bay August 11, 2023

Morro Bay Maritime Museum, Morro Bay Friday, August 11 – Sunday, August 20, 2023

In 1542, Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo, a Spanish explorer, voyaged to the Pacific Coast of what is now California aboard the ship San Salvador. This expedition is often regarded as a significant historical event, marking the first recorded European contact with the indigenous people of the region.

Cabrillo's expedition set the stage for a complex period of interaction between indigenous people and European settlers. The arrival of the San Salvador was the harbinger of deep transformations that drastically reshaped the lives of the native people.



This exhibition provides an unparalleled glimpse into the connection between indigenous leaders, their land, and their role in cultural revitalization. Kirti's culturally sensitive approach brings her subjects' stories to the forefront, educating viewers and promoting a more compassionate society. The ambition for this project is beyond a transient exhibit; it aims to become a traveling display across California, the U.S., and globally, and create lasting impressions through a permanent exhibit, a documentary, and a book that will further immortalize these compelling narratives.

This is an election year. If you plan on running for a council seat in this year's election you can drop off, send or email your letters of intent to the Tribal office starting September 17, 2023. They must be received no later than October 15, 2023. The earlier you get them in, they can be printed in the October and November newsletters. Remember you must be a qualified member at least 30 years of age. And for those elders wanting to run for an elder seat, you must be at least 65 years old. The terms of office are 4 years for council and 2 years for elder's council. The current council terms that are up this year and need to run are Sharon Thomas, Pamela Flood, Yvonne Davis, Patti Dunton, Robert Piatti, and John Piatti Jr. And for elders' council Yvonne Ayala, Kenneth Pierce, and Leslie Montgomery.
