

General Meeting May 18,2024 San Lorenzo Park King City Minutes



- I. Old Business-Meeting began at 1;15pm following lunch and led by Contemporary Lead: Gary Pierce
 - A. Don Jr. moved to approve the minutes from March 16, 2024 general meeting. Bruce 2nd the motion. Motion passed.
- B. Kenny gave a federal recognition report. It was asked why it is taking so long. Kenny explained how the process has changed over the years and that we are closer than ever before. He invited people to come to the next meeting, where Michael could go into more depth with them.
- c. Robert gave a lengthy monitoring update in which he discussed how this is our #1 source of income as a tribe. He explained the process of how our non profit is chosen and how they divide up the work amongst the 4 tribes monitoring the area. Mike asked about monitoring the SLO City projects and Robert told the group about the various projects. Robert also discussed AB52 and how it affects whether you are considered a tribe and if you are an MLD. This is becoming very important to us and the Heritage Committee is looking over their policies.
 - D. Mission Day report was deferred for Mary Rodgers to attend and discuss.
- E. **July Fundraiser** was discussed by Johnny P and Dayna. The fundraiser is **July 27, 2024** at the San Luis Sportsman Association. We will be doing Bingo, shooting, a BBQ and several opportunity drawings. Tickets are available at this meeting and council will have some at the Solstice, but you can always get them from Patti, at the office.
- F. The **Summer Solstice** is run by Bruce. We need gate volunteers. Josh Cody will be the guide. He has 5 people heading up the rock. It is **June 20th from 10-8**, but the pot luck is usually at lunch time as climbers get together and go up at 1pm. As always we need volunteers for both the Solstice and the BBQ fundraiser. Please contact Patti at the office to volunteer for either event.
- G. Salinan Flag ideas were present and will continue to be taken at the solstice. We will decide at the July 27th fundraiser which ideas will prevail.

II. Financial Report

A. Regular account balance is \$18, 838.71 and the Payroll account balance is \$10, 060.46.

III. New Business

- A. MLD report-Patti reported on human remains that washed out of Morro Creek a (jaw bone) and that she is working with the city of Morro Bay for a reburial. There is a project in Cayucos that is needing reburial, and she is looking to see if the Cayucos cemetery can give us a small plot like the Atascadero one does to burry remains that we can find a safe place for. We want them to remain undisturbed. She is working with Mona Tucker and the Northern Chumash in this endeavor.
- B. There was a joint law enforcement training that was huge over the Wagon Caves area. Robert is working on sending a formal complaint out about it. They had 20 RV's, campers, tents and families out at one of our very sensitive sites without our knowledge.
 - C. CA State Parks are doing new signage and would like any of us to report any that need updating.
 - D. TANF request for craters and Advisory Board position
- E. SLO Beaver Brigade and Central Coast Bioneers sent representatives to talk about the work they are doing and some of their upcoming events. Ken will post on the website so you can click on their links.

The Council will bring the designs to the May 18th meeting and the July fundraiser for a vote like the seal was done.







