

Indian Cemetery Work Day


At Mission San Antonio

Salinan Words of the Month **Guide to sounds** ts – sound at the end of cats Ma'yre k"e'! father av pie **tr** – make a t but curl your tongue aet ow mow (Come with me!) (almost sounds like a ch) beat. toy ov - sound in the middle of uh-oh hope (glottal stop) due Ke'yax he'k" P't'k'ts'ch' double vowels (aa, ae) are (I'm coming with you). consonants said at the same the same sound but longer time as a glottal stop ('); they in lentgh make a strong, emphasized pop! **x** – guttural throaty h sound


For Your Information!!!
